Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- U.S. citizen or permanent legal resident or LA resident and a registered voter in my parish of residence
- Read, write and speak English
- No felony convictions unless pardoned
- High school diploma or high school equivalency diploma

Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary E&O and supplies at <u>www.NationalNotary.org/LA/Renew</u> or I called 1-800-876-6827. When purchased, I indicated my parish.

Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

Step 4

I have filed the following with the Secretary of State:

- Original or certified true copy of my \$10,000/5-year bond or E&O that has been signed by the parish clerk of court
- State filing fee check or money order payable to the Secretary of State

Step 5

I have emailed a copy of my commission certificate to: <u>Releasing@nationalnotary.org</u>, or faxed to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3-5 business days.
